

## Downloading/Installing Ruby 1.8 on Ubuntu

Use the **Synaptic Package Manager** to download/install (or confirm the installation of) the following Ubuntu packages (note that ruby1.9 is a *developer/experimental version* – it is not yet stable, so do not use it).

Within the **Synaptic Package Manager**, be sure to use the *Settings ... Repositories* dialog to include the *restricted* and *multiverse* software sources, as well as the *Third Party* sources. (Do a “reload” when prompted to do so).
