Write a class called DrawBox which provides a simple text-based, box drawing facility. For example, when a programmer does this:

```
cube = DrawBox.new( :width => 4 )
```

the following appears on screen:

Whereas:

```
my box = DrawBox.new( :height => 3, :width => 2 )
```

produces this beautiful creation:

|--| | | |--|

Make sure a new DrawBox with no parameters to new does something sensible.
